## How do I go about making a gift to St Mark's in my Will?

To make a Bequest to St Mark's you might like to consider the wording suggested below. These clauses are simply intended to act as a guide when making your Will or making alterations to your Will by way of a Codicil. Your solicitor may be able to advise you in this area. There are also taxation implications that you may need to consider. So we recommend that you involve your family as well as legal and financial advisors in your decision to make a bequest to St Mark's.

## Unrestricted bequest sample wording

I give and bequeath free of all duties and taxes payable upon or as a consequence of my death the sum of (insert X% of my estate or value of gift) to St Mark's Anglican Church Darling Point (ABN 54 044 193 629) for the general purposes of the Church or as the Parish Council of the Church may determine and I declare that the receipt of the Rector and Churchwardens, Treasurer or other proper office of St Mark's Church shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Executor.

OR

I give and bequeath free of all duties and taxes payable upon or as a consequence of my death the sum of (insert X% of my estate or value of gift) to St Mark's Anglican Church Darling Point (ABN 54 044 193 629) for the improvement, purchase or maintenance of property in the parish of Darling Point as the Parish Council of the Church may determine and I declare that the receipt of the Rector and Churchwardens, Treasurer or other proper office of St Mark's Church shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Executor.

## Restricted Bequest suggested wording:

Should you wish for your Bequest to be used for a specific purpose, the following words could be added to the end of the Unrestricted Bequest clause: "It is my wish that this Bequest be applied for...".
