



St Mark's has a rich history of creative arts, including in religious music (particularly the maintenance of a historic and rare pipe organ). The church has looked to honour the bequest of the late Michael Crouch by establishing St Mark's Music. As a not-for-profit organisation, we are seeking tax deductible donations to further our cultural and creative arts activities in the wider community. The intention is to promote forms of creative arts (such as music, performing arts, film, video, visual arts, design, crafts, radio and literature) in a Christian context. Examples include organ recitals and performances, supporting Organ Scholars and other organists, organ maintenance, choir recitals and performances, and a community choir, including scholarships for members of the community choir. Audio-visual recordings of performances are also planned. Recently St Mark's Music has been able to offer several Choir Scholarships thanks to the generosity of Basil Sellers AM.
