Looking back to 2023

God has continued to bless our work and our community in 2023. We are so grateful for what God is doing among us by his Spirit, to the glory of Christ.

- 427 new faces came through our doors
- 107 (avg) screens watched our online services each week
- 20 people attended Alpha or Simply Christianity
- 25 people joined us as regular members
- 41 (avg) young people attended our kids and youth programs each week
- 223 (avg) came to church each week
- 37% of our regular members are in Connect Groups

Sadly, we have also said goodbye to beloved members of our community: Bev Cohen, Pam Hyles, Peter Muller, Stella Vaughan, Robert Wilson, and John Ziminski.

Throughout 2023, we had three main priorities of deeper community, witnessing to Christ, and raising lay leaders.

Witness

- Sermons on Daniel inspired us to stand for our faith no matter the cost, and our 'Myths of Sydney' and 'Where is...?' series showed us how the gospel makes sense of our deepest longings.
- Our St Mark's Conference: Witnessing Together informed, inspired, and equipped us to join in God's mission in the world together.
- Our Share Jesus course equipped us to share Jesus in our everyday lives in natural and achievable ways.

Community

- Biblical meals and Romans 9-16 urged us to show hospitable love to one another and those who are different to us.
- We had more meals together in one another's homes and in our time together at church.
- We started two new Connect Groups.

Leadership

- The staff team continued to gather, engage, and train our lay leaders.
- The staff team worked hard to step aside and make more space for lay leaders, and we saw people step up into leadership.

Effective outreach: We proclaim the gospel to the lost and look to see people won for Christ.




Active service: We pursue active faith expressed in works of love in the church, in the community, and in the world.



- Reflect on God's goodness in prayer and devotion with others.




KNOW — develop your knowledge of God and his ways.

Buildings
