

### **KIDS' CHURCH**

At St Mark's we value our children and run a comprehensive Kids' Church programme each Sunday of the year. At Kids' Church children are encouraged to discover God's word and his teachings through stories, songs, craft and drama. Our leaders are well trained and prepare new lessons and activities each week. St Mark's encourages children to investigate their own faith and our Kids' Church leaders, alongside parents, support this process.



#### ST MARK'S YOUTH GROUP

Every Friday night during term time the sounds of youth having fun can be heard coming from The Upper Hall at St Mark's Church as they enjoy the St Mark's Youth group. Designed for young people in school Years 6 - 12, the group meets from 6.45pm - 8.30pm (with the program starting at 7pm) and offers free activities that suit all levels of skill. A typical week involves enjoying varied physical and creative activities, music, and hearing something encouraging from God's word.

#### MUSICTIME

MusicTime is held on Mondays during term time 9.30am – 10.30am at The Howard Lea Hall at St Mark's. This group offers a fun and friendly community where children can learn with song and dance, while adults enjoy the opportunity to connect with other parents. Each week there is a structured music class, followed by free play and morning tea.

### SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

Recognising the important role of families in today's society, St Mark's offers a range of courses to support families in their relationships.
